Saco-S at the University of Gothenburg

Saco is a labor organisation for federally employed academics and consists of 21 Saco Unions which together have 700 000 members. As a member of a Saco trade union, you are included in our collective bargaining and entitled to support from local Saco-S representatives. These Saco-S council elected representatives negotiate with the employer in questions regarding your and other member's employment at the University of Gothenburg.

Fackförbundet ST - the Union of Civil Servants - organises all employees who work for state agencies, companies employed by the state, universities, colleges and state financed foundations.
